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Prospective authors must adhere to the following guidelines: (1) Article length is 10 pages minimum and 20 pages maximum, including references and appendices; (2) Abstract and its key words are included; (3) Article may be written by three persons maximum; (4) Article may also be written in English as well as in Indonesian and Malay languages; and (5) Attach a bio mentioning author's current profession, photograph, and postal and e-mail addresses.
